This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students meeting the NMS in Writing from 76.0% to 88% for Yr 5 by 2020
- Increase the Mean Scale Score of students in Yr 3 Numeracy from 387.1 to 395 in Yr 3 by 2020
- Increase the Mean Scale Score of students in Yr 5 Numeracy from 469.4 to 488 in Yr 3 by 2020
- Increase the proportion of students in the U2B in Writing from 2.9% to 15% in Yr 5 in 2020
- Ensure students achieve the NMS for literacy and numeracy for their year level **or** have a school developed evidence-based plan, in place to address their specific learning difficulties
- Improve teacher capability and pedagogical practices, in response to Trauma Informed Practice
- Improve student outcomes based on early intervention with occupational therapy, speech pathology, on-site paediatrician and capacity building of TA's and Teachers with appropriate and targeted PD.

Our initiatives include

- Review student data each term (ie NAPLAN, Pat-R, Pat-M, attendance) and provide a learning plan for all Year 3, 4 and 5 students below the NMS
- Link with tertiary institutions & specialists to implement programs in Early Years Education, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Dietician and Hearing difficulties
- Implement pedagogical strategies based on evidence from standardized testing, moderated school data and Effect Size measures, underpinned by the works of Dr Anne Bayetto, Dr John Hattie, John Fleming and Michael Fullen
